Romans 3

Introduction

1. What is your most prominent Easter memory? Why?
2. Among your relatives, who comes closest to being your family’s spiritual patriarch/matriarch?

Digging Deeper

3. When did you first become aware of your sinfulness and need for God?
4. Have two people read aloud verses 1-6. The first reader reads verses 1, 3, and 5 (the questions), while the second reader reads verses 2, 4, and 6 (the responses). Identify the three questions and talk about how the author, Paul, answers each of them?
5. How is sin defined in our society?
6. Reading verses 10-18, list what is said regarding human thought, direction, speech and action. How does this list make you feel?
7. From verses 19-20, what is the Law’s purpose?
8. Based on the sermon, what “benefits” are available?
9. Discuss the role and importance of blood as it relates to being in a right relationship with God.

Application

10. Why is it so difficult for many people to accept the fact that salvation is a free gift? How do you deal with that reality? How does it impact you sharing your faith?
11. What will you remember about this Easter Sunday (sermon) worship experience?
