Introduction

1. What is something you consistently find yourself fighting for?
2. What is your favorite restaurant and why?

3. What was going on in Crete that made the appointment of such Elders important (v. 10-16)?
4. How are these issues still relevant today?
5. What evidence is there in this letter that these false teachers were evil, unrepentant unbelievers?
6. Where do you think the “false teaching” (referenced in this passage) came from or had its origin? Where does it flow out of today?
7. Can you think of someone who through the course of their life fit the description provided in verse 16? What impact did they have?
8. What relevance does Titus 2:1 have for your life specifically? How are you doing that? With whom?

9. Based on the sermon, what are three things worth “fighting” for? Why? How will you do that this week?
